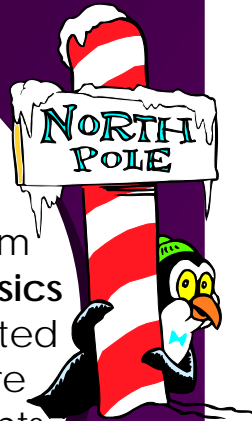

Wyvern Primary School has applied for £1,200 from the Rushey Mead Ward community fund. It will be put to good use to help motivate pupils by awarding them with prizes for achievements. Ward Councillors will decide whether to grant the cash at a future community meeting.



Four students have won a trip to the **Arctic** after coming 1st in a national environmental competition. The students from the **University of Leicester's Physics & Astronomy Department** created projects for the Npower Future Leaders Challenge, the students created workshops for primary school, GCSE & uni students.



Linden Primary is quickly improving after education expert Peter Thorpe was drafted in for help after the school was placed in special measures in May. OFSTED returned last month and confirmed it was making rapid progress. The school will soon be out of special measures.



A new Ofsted report published last week grades **Little Bowden School** in Harborough 'good' and praises pupils' progress and achievements.

Leicestershire City Council are introducing a string of measures to make it safer for 3,000 pupils travelling to 3 schools. The plans are to widen the footpaths of near by streets and to ban parking outside the schools. The £200,000 improvements will be made to **Beauchamp College, Gartree High and Brocks Hill Primary School**



The next 6 secondary schools to have a £43.9 Million revamp have been announced - **St. Pauls Catholic School, Hamilton Community College, Nether Hall School, Keyham Lodge, Milgate School** and the **Children's Hospital School** are all to have a makeover. Work commences over this summer and will take around 2 years.
